Note A: Polity is a half-course (six weeks) that does not appear in ACORN. Students who wish to register for Polity must do so by completing and forwarding the Polity Registration Request form to the Assistant Registrar along with a half-course tuition fee no later than the Friday of the week prior to the start of classes in September. Since Polity does not appear on ACORN, Polity will not appear on an official Knox College transcript.

Note B: Theological Field Education (TFE) is a two-semester ministry placement for those students directed to complete a TFE placement by the Committee on Education and Reception (E&R). This is a pass/fail program component that will appear in the student's academic record as an "Extra" course registration as per E&R requirements.

Note C: Where a student enters with previous coursework equivalent to one or more of KNH1015H, KNB1006H, KNB1501H, the Faculty Advisor may waive the requirement in favour of a substitute course in the same area of study. No courses may be taken outside of Knox without the Faculty Advisor's prior approval.
