NOTE A: *The CTS requires that a student complete Five Foundational (1000-level) courses and Two Additional courses (2000 and/or 3000-level). A student who has completed a foundational course in an area may be allowed to substitute a 2000 or 3000-level course in its place.*

NOTE B: Reading & Research Courses are not normally permitted in the CTS program unless a student has been directed to take a specific course by the PCC Committee on Education & Reception (E&R) that is not being offered in a given year, and the student is otherwise planning to finish all E&R requirements in that year.

NOTE C: “Extra” Courses – A student who has been directed by the PCC Committee on Education & Reception (E&R) to undertake a program of study consisting of ten (10) courses will need to register for TFE and one additional course beyond the required seven (7) certificate program courses. The TFE and additional course registrations will be noted as “Extra” courses in the student’s academic record and on the student’s transcript.

NOTE D: Theological Field Education (TFE) is a two-semester ministry placement for those students directed to complete a TFE placement by the Committee on Education and Reception (E&R). This is a pass/fail program component that will appear in the student’s academic record as an “Extra” course registration as per E&R requirements.

NOTE E: Course Substitutions for Program Requirements listed above requires approval by Faculty Advisor and Director of Basic Degree Studies. Please complete and submit the Course Substitution Request form for approval prior to course registration.
